



## Frequently Asked Questions for the Flu Immunisations in School

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the flu vaccination process in schools will be slightly different. We hope this information can provide some further insight into how the session will take place in order to keep everyone safe.

### What PPE will be worn?

All staff will wear face masks and disposable aprons at all times. Gloves will not be worn, but antibacterial gel will be used on hands/arms between every child. PPE will be changed between each bubble or class.

### Will the children be socially distanced?

As a team, we will be led by your child's school and follow their guidelines. Children will be distanced wherever possible.

### How many staff will come into school?

As few nurses as possible will attend the session to reduce visitors into the school. This could range from 2-5 depending on the size of the school.

As per government guidelines, please do not send your child to school if they are showing any symptoms of COVID-19. Guidance on symptoms can be found here:
